

### Mini-Term Rotation in Evening: Core Curriculum

Because of responsibilities with work and family some students are better able to commit to 7-week terms than to 15-week terms. The shorter term allows them to work around business trips mandated by their work or to plan around medical procedures for their children or aging parents. With this fact in mind, each Fall and Spring semester we offer a variety of courses in two shortened terms: Session 2 ends at roughly midterm of the 15-week semester while Session 3 begins at mid-term and ends at the same time as the 15-week semester ends. More importantly, we have a carefully orchestrated rotation of courses that will allow any student to complete the Core of the University System of Georgia *attending only during mini-terms*.
